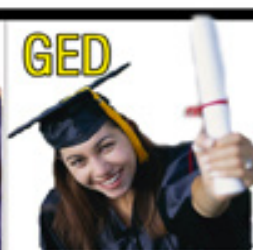

HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS



Students have the opportunity to earn a regular high school credit diploma. Many of our students in this program are dual enrolled while attending one of the seven major high schools. Making up a class or two at Shaw often enables students to graduate with their high school classmates. There are online credit classes available for students to earn new credit or make-up credit.

GED



PREPARATION

This Program prepares students for the State of Florida High School Diploma. We strive to motivate students not only to obtain a GED, but also to utilize the acquired skills in the workforce and to achieve career and vocational training and job placement success. There are also online classes for students with busy schedules or medical conditions that prevent them from attending an actual classroom.

ADULT BASIC EDUCATION



This is designed for the student to obtain a level of education designed to improve the employability of the student through instruction in mathematics, reading and language.

Pre GED

The PreGED Program targets 16 - 17 year old students who have been unsuccessful in the traditional Middle School program and are planning to withdraw from Middle School. This program provides educational experiences to prepare students for success by providing essential academics in language arts: writing and reading, mathematics, science, and social studies correlated to Sunshine State Standards. Once students complete this program, they are eligible to enter Shaw's High School Program, GED Program, or surrounding high schools with the GED Exit Option Program.
